As A Room Deodorant

General -- Spray into air to remove obnoxious odors.

Kitchen - Periodically spray closets, refrigerators, lockers and garbage receptacles to deodorize. Avoid any spraying of

Restrooms - In order to deodorize following normal cleaning of fixtures, spray on lavatories, showers, toilet bowls and seats.

As An Air Sanitizer

Hold dispenser upright point opening away from face. Spray into air towards center of room for 3 to 4 seconds per 1000 cu. ft. of space.


