# SELECT-O-KIL

**SELECTIVE WEED KILLER FOR LAWNS/RECREATION AREAS FOR THE SELECTIVE CONTROL OF MANY BROAD-LEAVED WEEDS IN NON-CROP AREAS.**

SELECT-O-KIL is recommended for controlling giant ragweed, tall fescue, lamb's-quarters, mustards, goosegrass, smartweed, shepherd's-purse, tarweed, thistle, vetch, wild carrot, wild geranium, wild radish, and many other broad-leaved weeds without injury to most grasses. Use on lawns, parks, playgrounds, and other recreation areas; on airfields, ditch banks, around buildings.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

The lower dosages will usually be satisfactory only for young, succulent growth of sensitive weeds, such as listed for use on lawns and under conditions where kill is difficult, use the higher dosage. **MIX ONLY WITH WATER.** In mixing sprays, add half the water to the tank, then add the SELECT-O-KIL with agitation and finally the balance of the water with continued agitation. Apply at low pressure (30 to 50 pounds) during warm weather when weeds are young and growing actively.

WEED CONTROL TREATMENT CHART

AREAS TO BE TREATED	DILUTION	METHODS OF APPLICATION
For General Weed Control  Young succulent growth stage	1 part SELECT-O-KIL to 200 parts water (2 qts. per 100 gals. water) (1 oz. per 1.5 gals. water)	Use low pressure (30-50 p.s.i.) spray equipment. Wet all foliage thoroughly.
Established Weed Growth  Perennial weeds	1 part SELECT-O-KIL to 128 parts water (3 qts. per 100 gals. water) (1 oz. per gallon water)	
Small Areas Young succulent growth stage	1 part SELECT-O-KIL to 382 parts water (1 oz. per 3 gals. water)	Wet weeds thoroughly by means of hand operated tank sprayer or sprinkling can.
Small Areas Perennial weed established growth	1 part SELECT-O-KIL to 192 parts water (2 oz. per 3 gals. water)	

The Holcomb FAN-JET Sprayer will treat approximately 3,000 square feet per three gallon capacity.

### HANDLING PRECAUTIONS

CAUSES IRRITATION OF SKIN AND EYES. DO NOT GET INTO EYES, ON SKIN OR ON CLOTHING.

### KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

In case of contact, flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes and get medical attention; wash skin with soap and plenty of water. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before re-use. Do not wear contaminated shoes. Harmful if swallowed.

**NOTE:** Holcomb SELECT-O-KIL, exposed to subfreezing temperatures, should be warmed to at least 40° F. and mixed thoroughly before using.

**WARNING:** Do not use on lawns of creeping grasses, such as bent grass or on freshly seeded turf until grass has become well established. Most legumes are usually damaged or killed.

**USE PRECAUTIONS:** Do not apply SELECT-O-KIL directly to, or otherwise permit it to come into contact with vegetables, flowers, grapes, fruit trees, ornamentals, cotton, or other desirable plants which are sensitive to SELECT-O-KIL and similar materials, and do not permit spray mist containing it to drift onto them, since even minute quantities of this spray may cause severe injury during both growing and dormant period. (Coarse sprays are less likely to drift.)

Do not use same spray equipment for other purposes.

Do not store near fertilizers, seeds, insecticides, or fungicides. Do not contaminate water used for irrigation or domestic purposes.
