DIRECTIONS

Certain species of ants, ticks, fleas, and chiggers may be controlled on lawns and park areas by mixing 4 ounces concentrate to 5 gallons water for an area spray of approximately 1800 square feet. Apply spray liberally, repeat at intervals as necessary. For control of Red Harvester Ant and certain other colony forming ants, use 4 ounces Concentrate to five gallons water, or 1 tablespoon to 5 pints water. Pour as much of this mixture as possible into ant holes and saturate a small area completely around each hill or colony.

Keep children and pets off treated areas until this material is washed into the soil and grass is dry.

NOTICE: Do not use this product on any pasture lands or grazing areas which dairy animals or other animals being finished for slaughter may have access. Do not use in poultry houses.



For use in the control of the Western Harvester Ant. Apply at the rate of 1 lb. of Blue Streak per each 700 square feet of area, or 62½ lbs. per acre which would be the equivalent to 1.25 lbs. actual Heptachlor per acre. Broadcast treatment should be limited to lawns, cemeteries, golf courses, and non-food crop areas. For treatment of individual colonies, sprinkle approximately one ounce of Blue Streak Ant Bait around the edge of ant hill or mound. Mound treatment should be limited to non-food crop areas.

WARNINGS:

This product will kill fish and wild life. Birds and other wild life in treated areas may be harmed. Keep out of any body of water. Apply this product only as specified on this label. Treatment may be repeated in 10 days if necessary for control.
