Directions for Use as a Spray:

FOR CATTLE: TICKS, HORNF LIES, and LICE use at rate of 1 gallon TPC TOX-A-DANE to 150 gallons of water, or 1 pint TOX-A-DANE to 20 gallons of water. Mix thoroughly. Spray animals all over. Thorough wetting of animals is essential for best results. Repeat as needed for control.

For use on Back-Rubbing Devices for the control of Hornflies and an aid in controlling Lice on Beef Cattle. Dilute 1 pint TOX-A-DANE with 2 gallons of water. Repeat application on devices at two to three week intervals or as needed.

FOR SHEEP AND GOATS: Lice and Sheep Ticks (Ked), use at the rate of 1 gallon TPC TOX-A-DANE to 450 gallons of water, or 1 pint TOX-A-DANE to 60 gallons of water. Spray animals thoroughly until completely wet. One application will usually give good control of these pests; however, repeat treatment as necessary for control.

FOR FLEECE WORMS AND TICKS, use TPC TOX-A-DANE at the rate of 1 gallon to 150 gallons of water, or 1 pint TOX-A-DANE to 20 gallons of water. Wet sheep thoroughly with spray. Repeat as needed for control.

FOR HOES: LICE use TOX-A-DANE at the rate of 1 gallon to 150 gallons of water, or 1 pint to 20 gallons of water. Usually one application is sufficient to control this pest. Repeat as needed.

FOR RESIDUAL SURFACE SPRAY: FLIES AND TPC TOX-A-DANE at the rate of 1 gallon to 40 1 pint to 5 gallons of water. Spray surfaces thoroughly wet, but not to the point of excess outside walls of dairy barns, fences, inside hog pens. Repeat as needed for control.

Do not use in poultry houses. Do not use on caged pets.

Rinse equipment and containers and dispose of in proper manner away from water supplies.

Tick-Rubbing Devices for the Control of Hornflies and an irritating Lice on Beef Cattle. Dilute 1 pint TOX-A-DANE with 20 gallons of water. Repeat application on devices at two to three days or as needed.

AND GOATS Lice and Sheep Ticks (Ked) Use at the rate of 1 gallon TPC TOX-A-DANE to 450 gallons of water, or 1 pint to 60 gallons of water. Spray animals thoroughly until wet. One application will usually give good control of lice. However, repeat treatment as necessary for control.

WORMS AND TICKS Use TPC TOX-A-DANE at the rate of 1 gallon to 150 gallons of water, or 1 pint TOX-A-DANE to 20 gallons of water. Wet sheep thoroughly with spray. Repeat as needed.

LICE Use TOX-A-DANE at the rate of 1 gallon to 150 gallons of water, or 1 pint to 20 gallons of water. Usually one application is sufficient to control this pest. Repeat as needed.

Do not spray within 30 days of slaughter or permit animal access to backrubbers within 30 days of slaughter. Do not dip animals within 60 days of slaughter.

FOR RESIDUAL SURFACE SPRAY: FLIES AND MOSQUITOES: Use TPC TOX-A-DANE at the rate of 1 gallon to 40 gallons of water or 1 pint to 5 gallons of water. Spray surfaces to be treated until thoroughly wet, but not to the point of excessive run off. Spray outside walls of dairy barns, fences, inside hogs pens, and garbage cans. Repeat as needed for control.

Do not use in poultry houses. Do not use on cats, dogs, and household pets.

Toxic to fish and wildlife. Do not contaminate streams, lakes or ponds with spray or washing from spray tanks.

Rinse equipment and containers and dispose of waste by burying in non-crop lands away from water supplies.
