

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Screw-worm and Blow Fly Infestations:

Apply with swab or brush, working into deep pockets. Also spread around and over drainage area below wound. Repeat applications at 5 to 7 day intervals as needed. Free bleeding wounds may require several applications.

To prevent Screw-worm and Blow Fly Infestations:

Treat fresh wounds resulting from dehorning, castrations, shear cuts, etc. Also treat wounds of newborn animals. Retreat as needed. **Prevents Worm and other Blow Fly Infestations of Sheep and Goats:**

Mix one part TPC Livestock Smear with nine parts water. Apply as a wash on and around infested areas. Retreat every 3 days until infestation is controlled.

Ear Tick and Mite Control:

Pour undiluted smear in ears or apply with brush or swab. Repeat treatment every 3 days until infestation is controlled.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid inhalation. Irritating to the skin. Avoid contact with skin. Injurious to eyes. Do not get in eyes. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Avoid contamination of food and feedstuff.
