

Directions For Use:
The ears of cattle should be treated at the time of the Spring and Fall Round ups or at other times if necessary. This may be done by using an ordinary pint size press-bottom oil can which has had the spout cut off to a length of 2 inches and a 3-inch piece of flexible rubber tubing of about 3/8 inch diameter slipped over the spout to guard against injury of ear lining while oil can spout is being inserted. For best results, employ the following procedure when using TPC Ear Tick Remedy: Grasp the animal's ear with the left hand, insert rubber covered oil can spout carefully, and inject 1/2 oz. of TPC Ear Tick Remedy in the ear, approximately three squirts from oiler, roll the ear gently between thumb and fingers of left hand while injection is being made in order to facilitate the spread of mixture over the inner-surface of the ear, then hold in an upright position for a few seconds after injection is finished to permit fluid to settle into the ear canal. Repeat treatment every 3 days until infestation is controlled. One gallon of TPC Ear Tick Remedy will treat approximately 125 head of cattle.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid inhalation. Irritating to skin. Avoid contact with skin. Injurious to eyes. Do not get in eyes. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling. In case of human eye contact, flush eyes immediately with plenty of water and get prompt medical attention. Ronnel is a cholinesterase inhibitor; should poisoning occur, obtain prompt medical aid. Note to physician: Atropine is antidotal. Avoid contamination of food and feedstuff.

Ronnel is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Do not use this product on animals simultaneously or within a few days before or after treatment with or exposure to cholinesterase inhibiting drugs, pesticides or chemicals.

Do not reuse empty container. Destroy by perforating or crushing and discarding in safe place or burying with other waste. This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams, or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.
