

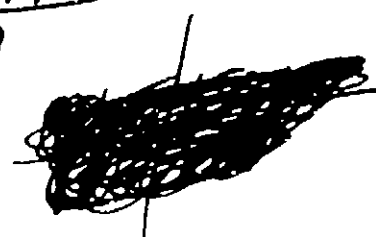

Subject: Amendment - Updated Formula & Revised Label  
Prentox® Residual Concentrated DV-One  
EPA Registration No. 655-441  
Your Application Dated December 27, 1984

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. According to our calculations from the new Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated December 27, 1984, the Xylene Range Aromatic Solvent comprises 75.93% of your product. Please indicate this percentage on the label ingredient statement. The percentage of inerts on the label will therefore be 5.88%.
2. On the label under the heading Physical or Chemical Hazards, please indicate "Do not use or store near heat or open flame."
3. As indicated to your firm previously, in the use directions on ornamentals revise "webworm" to "oakworm" in the pest name "orange striped oakworm."
4. Also in this section provide equivalency footnotes for DDVP., or delete the three footnotes relating to chlorpyrifos.

Your Application Dated October 31, 1984

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

At the next label printing make the following revisions:

1. Diazinon is no longer a registered trademark of Ciba-Geigy. Therefore all such reference should be deleted. Also, the use of "diazinon" in front of the chemical name or as a simple footnote to the ingredients statement is advised.
2. For the storage and disposal text, since most uses are in domestic situations, use of the homeowner disposal text is appropriate. Therefore substitute the following for your disposal text.

**Disposal**

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap original container in newspaper and discard in trash.

3. A Statement of Practical Treatment must be added to the labeling. We suggest the following statement; however, if your toxicological data suggest otherwise, please submit a draft Statement of Practical Treatment for prior approval:

If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

If inhaled - Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

If on skin - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

If in eyes - Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

Note to Physician - Solvent presents aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate is antidotal. 2-Pam is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

4. Since you are claiming use in hospitals, add the following to the precautionary text. "Do not use in hospital or clinic rooms, such as patients' rooms, wards, nurseries, operating or emergency rooms. Do not use in any room where infants, the sick, or aged are or will be present for any extended period of confinement."
5. The Agency does not recognize use of the word "combustible." Therefore delete it from the labeling.

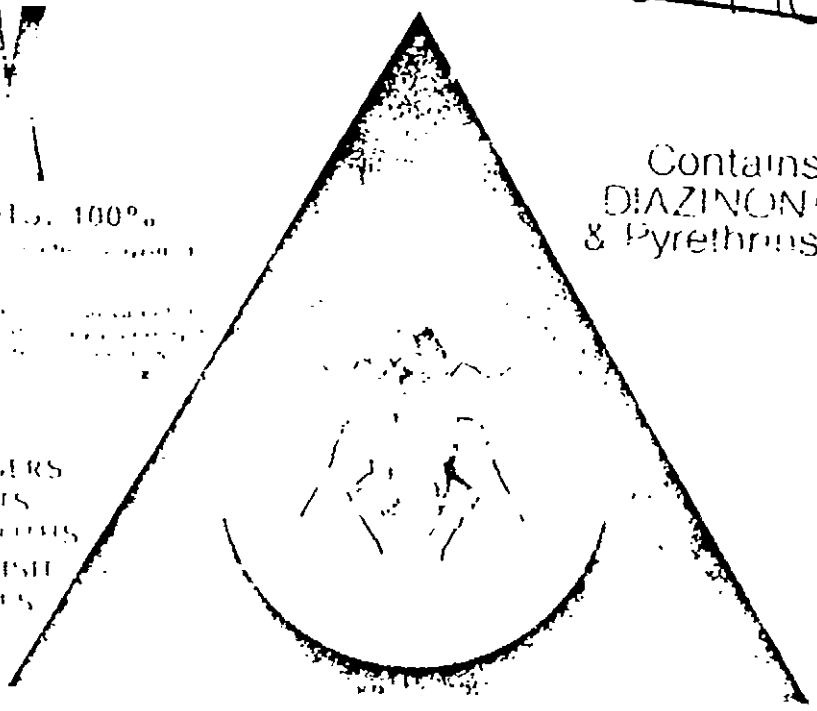
