**HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

**WARNING:** Causes eye and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. After handling, wash thoroughly with soap and water. Harmful if swallowed. Do not taste or swallow.

**IF SWALLOWED:** Rinse mouth with water. Promptly drink a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Immediately call a Poison Control Center or physician. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Probable mucous membrane irritation may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures may be needed against circulatory shock, respiratory depression, and convulsions.

**STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**

**IF ON SKIN:** Immediately remove any contaminated clothing and flush affected skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. If irritation persists, call a physician. Wash all contaminated clothing before reuse.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**GENERAL:** For disinfecting, do not use in combination with any soap, cleaner, disinfectant, or sanitizer. Disinfectant solutions should not be made with hard water; it reduces germicidal activity. Previously-used or contaminated solutions may be reused for cleaning, but not for disinfecting or deodorizing. A 10 minute contact time is required for complete disinfection.

**FOR CLEANING WALLS, FURNITURE, FIXTURES, AND OTHER VARNISHED, WAXED, OR ENAMELED SURFACES:** Use 3 fl oz/gal (24 mL/L) of warm water. Clean in the usual way, using a cloth, towel, sponge, or other applicator.

**FOR CLEANING FLOORS:** Use 4 fl oz/gal (32 mL/L) of lukewarm water. Use a mop, scrub brush, or cleaning machine in the usual manner. At this dilution, it will clean a waxed floor without removing the wax.

**FOR DISINFECTING:** Clean surfaces as directed above. Make a fresh disinfectant solution in a clean container, using 2 fl oz/gal (16 mL/L) of water. Apply this solution to the surface with a clean mop, cloth, towel, sponge, or other cleaning machine, or other applicator. Make sure that surface is thoroughly wetted.

**FOR DEODORIZING:** Reduces odor-causing bacteria and deodorizes surfaces. Follow directions above for disinfecting, except use 1 fl oz/gal (8 mL/L) of water.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**


**GENERAL:** Do not contaminate other materials, including drinking water, drinks, foods, or feeds, during transport, use, storage, or disposal. If damaged, leaking, or spilled, soak up and wrap waste, then dispose of as below.

**STORAGE:** Keep in upright, tightly closed original container in a cool, dry, locked area away from flames, sparks, sunlight, other chemicals, or other sources of ignition, heat, degradation, or contamination. Keep from freezing.

**DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Rinse original container thoroughly, then securely wrap in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

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**FOR CLEANING FLOORS:** Use 4 fl oz/gal (32 mL/L) of lukewarm water. Use a mop, scrub brush, or cleaning machine in the usual manner. At this dilution, it will clean a waxed floor without removing the wax.

**FOR DISINFECTING:** Clean surfaces as directed above. Make a fresh disinfectant solution in a clean container, using 2 fl oz/gal (16 mL/L) of water. Apply this solution to the surface with a clean mop, cloth, towel, sponge, sprayer, or other cleaning machine, or other applicator. Make sure that surface is thoroughly wetted.

**FOR DEODORIZING:** Reduces odors of bacteria and deodorizes surfaces. Flush surfaces above for disinfecting, except use 16 mL/L of water.


