### CLAIMS AND USES

**VIRUCIDAL**- Inactivates these agents: Human immunodeficiency virus Type 1 (HIV-1; a retrovirus that causes "AIDS" [Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome]); Herpes simplex Types 1 and 2 (herpesviruses); Vaccinia (a poxvirus); and Influenza A2/Hong Kong (a myxovirus).

**BACTERICIDAL**- kills these species: *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*, *Salmonella choleraesuis*, and *Staphylococcus aureus*.

**FUNGICIDAL**- kills these species: *Aspergillus niger*, *Penicillium variable*, and *Trichophyton mentagrophytes* (formerly *T. interdigitale*).

**CONTROLS MOLD/MILDEW** inhibits the growth of *Aspergillus niger* and *Penicillium variable* fungi.

**USED IN:** Hospitals, institutions, office buildings, schools, factories, motels, hotels, cafeterias, restaurants, and food processing plants.

**USED ON:** Counter tops • Table tops • Plastic surfaces • Sinks • Bathtubs • Shower stalls • Grouting • Tiles • Wash basins • Formica • Exhaust fans • Stainless steel • Woodwork • Porcelain • Enameled surfaces • Leather • Leatherette • Vinyl • Plastic.

Leaves the surface clean and free from odors. Excellent for all bathroom fixtures, grouting, tile, and shower stalls.

Contains no abrasives.

Also excellent for cleaning vinyl, leather, and plastic upholstery, varnished, painted, and enameled surfaces.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**GENERAL:** After using this product on food processing equipment and food contact surfaces, rinse off thoroughly with potable water.

**TO CLEAN:** Remove cap. Shake. Spray evenly over the surface. Wipe clean. For heavily soiled surfaces, allow foam to remain for a minute before wiping.

**SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR CLEANING AND DECONTAMINATING AGAINST HIV-1 (AIDS VIRUS) ON SURFACES/OBJECTS SOILED WITH BLOOD/BODY FLUIDS.** Wear disposable gloves, gowns, masks or eye coverings when handling items soiled with blood/body fluids. Blood and other body fluids must be thoroughly cleaned from surfaces and objects before application of this disinfectant. Blood and other body fluids, and cleaning materials removed from surfaces/objects should be autoclaved and disposed of according to Federal, State, and local regulations for infectious waste disposal.

**TO DISINFECT** and to treat 30" fungus (pathogenic fungi) on bath & locker room walls & floors, in showers & tubs, on painted surfaces, and on other hard, non-porous equipment and materials: Clean surface thoroughly as directed above, then spray a thin coat of foam, making sure it covers the entire surface to be disinfected. Allow foam to remain for at least 10 minutes, then wipe off with a clean damp cloth.

**FOR MOLD/MILDEW CONTROL:** Spray pre-cleaned surface as directed above. Wipe with clean damp cloth and allow to air dry. Repeat application when growth reappears.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**GENERAL:** Do not contaminate other materials, including water, food, or feed, during transport, storage, use, or disposal. If damaged or leaking, soak up and wring, if safe, then dispose of as below.

**STORAGE:** Keep in a cool, dry, locked area inaccessible to children and away from flames, sparks, sunlight, and other sources of heat or ignition. Containers heated above 130°F (54°C) may burst.

**DISPOSAL:** Retasten protective cap on container, securely wrap in several layers of newspaper, and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
