

AQUA-CIDE

DANGER:

Keep Out of Reach of Children. Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

FIRST AID:

DIRECTIONS

FOR SWIMMING POOLS

The pool should be cleaned, refilled and treated with an initial dose, followed by a maintenance dose as directed.

INITIAL DOSE: Use 1 gallon per 10,000 gallons of water. If pool has visible algae growth, the initial dose should be repeated within 48 hours after the algal debris is removed from the pool.

MAINTENANCE DOSE: Add 1 quart per 50,000 gallons of water at least every seven days. If high temperatures prevail or pool has unusually heavy use, add maintenance dose more frequently.

Algae static concentrations of 2 to 5 parts per million of active ingredients should be maintained. See serviceman for suitable test kit.

DIRECTIONS

FOR LOCKER ROOM DISINFECTION

Clean walkways, and poolside and locker room floors with a suitable, compatible detergent. Then mop with one ounce per gallon of water.

Wash suits and caps thoroughly—then immerse in a solution containing one part of this concentrate per gallon of water for at least 10 minutes. Rinse thoroughly with water, wring and hang to dry.
