GREEN KILL can be used around shrubbery beds if extreme caution is exercised to prevent drift on any desirable foliage.

DANGER: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Causes skin irritation. Do not breathe vapor or spray mist. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling. In case of contact, wash skin with soap and water; for eyes, immediately flush with large amounts of water for at least 15 minutes, and get medical attention. Remove contaminated clothing.
