The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Make these changes before you release the product for shipment:

- 1. Revise your "Precautionary Statements" as follows:

Precautionary Statements

Hazards To Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash contaminated skin promptly with soap and warm water. For eyes flush with water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs.

Do not apply to food crops.

Physical Hazards

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

- 2. Delete "General Classification" from your label.

3. At the end of your "Outdoor" use directions, add:

NOTE: This product is not likely to break the established urination patterns of dogs, unless it is used as a training aid.

4. Modify your "Storage and Disposal" Statements as follows:

Storage and Disposal

Storage: Store only in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

Disposal: When empty, replace cap, securely wrap in newspaper, and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Do not contaminate foods, feeds, or surfaces that they may contact. Do not apply to food crops.

Physical/Chemical Hazards

Flammable. Do not use or store near heat, sparks, or open flames. Do not use in the vicinity of pilot lights. Contents under pressure. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F(54°C) may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

GENERAL: Remove protective cap. Hold container upright. Point spray opening away from face and other persons or pets. For both indoor and outdoor situations, the most effective control for a pet is the sharply spoken word, backed up with disciplinary action. This repellent product should be used in conjunction with training.

INDOORS- To break your pet of undesirable habits (such as sleeping on furniture, rugs, and other forbidden areas in your home): Spray the article of furniture, rug, etc., lightly with this product so that the area or object is slightly moistened. Before spraying extensive areas of rugs, fabrics, or plastics, test the effect of this product by first treating a small, inconspicuous area. This product may stain or soften some fabrics or plastics. An alternate method to avoid possible damage is to spray a piece of cloth lightly and place it on the object or area in your home to be protected. Repeat daily, or as necessary, until undesirable habit is broken.

OUTDOORS- To prevent your pet, or stray animals, from soiling flower beds, areas of lawn, trees, shrubbery, or evergreens: Spray the edges of flower beds, trunks of trees, the bases of shrubbery and evergreens, patches of lawn, etc., lightly every day, or every other day, with this product. Stray animals are frequently attracted to areas where urine or feces have been deposited. First, remove any droppings, then spray the spot with this masking odor. Re-apply as often as necessary until undesirable habits of your pet or stray animals are changed. Do not apply directly to foliage of shrubs or to ornamental, soft-bodied plants.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORE in a cool, dry area away from flames, sparks, and other sources of heat or ignition. Containers heated above 130°F(54°C) may burst. For DISPOSAL, replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
