DIRECTIONS

This product is a concentrate and MUST be diluted with water according to directions and always rinse well immediately with water when used on Porcelain Enamel, such as bath tubs, lavatories and sinks.

For toilet bowl and urinal cleaning, flush toilet and remove as much water as possible by plunging. Apply with the yarn mop and allow to remain on the surface at least 10 minutes until all rust, stains and scales are loosened. Clean upper part of bowl, under the flush rim and down into the trap. To remove odor and incrustations in trap, pour 2 ounces into urinal and allow to remain for as long as possible.

To clean bathtubs, sinks, wash basins, shower stalls, drinking fountains, coffee urns, sterilizers, brass rails, ceramic tile floors and other enameled and plated surfaces, always dilute with 3 parts water. Apply with sponge or mop. Do not allow solution to remain on fixture without immediately thoroughly rinsing with water.

FIRST AID:
