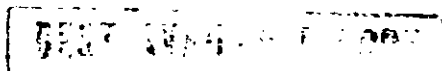

For use as a flank and udder wash, dilute 1/4 oz of product per gallon of water. For use in hospitals and households, dilute 1/2 oz of product per gallon of water.

DIRECTIONS (continued)
DISINFECTING PROCEDURES FOR GENERAL CLEAN, NON-POROUS SURFACES (such as floors, walls, non food contact surfaces) including scrubbing, followed by a potable water rinse solution by diluting 1/2 oz of water. Apply this freshly-made mop, sprayer, cleaning machine. Make sure surface is completely dry. Requires a minimum of 10 minutes.
PROCEDURES FOR DISINFECTING AND INSTITUTIONS To assure aeruginosa bacteria, follow same ppm active quaternary solution to 1 gal (8 mL/L) with water.

SANITIZING PROCEDURES FOR SANITIZING EATING AND DRINKING ESTABLISHMENTS AND FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS To sanitize all gross food contact surfaces, scrub with a good detergent, potable water rinse. After cleaning and rinsing, pre-sanitize solution by diluting 1/4 oz with water in a clean container with a clean applicator by spraying, flooding of applicable larger surfaces, or sink filled with sanitizing solution. Used sanitizing solution may have applications. Make sure all surfaces are dry. Then allow the sanitizing solution to remain on the surface for 10 minutes. Then allow the sanitizing solution to drain. Then allow the surface to air dry. Then allow the surface to be used.
PROCEDURES FOR SANITIZING TEATS OF DAIRY COWS Pre-sanitize solution by diluting 1/4 oz warm water in a clean container applicator which has been dipped. Wet these areas on each animal thoroughly before milking. Do not use the solution. Use fresh solution or diluted.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL
GENERAL Do not contaminate water, drinks, foods, or feeds. Dispose of damaged, leaking, or then dispose of as below.
STORAGE Keep in upright, tight, dry, locked area inaccessible to sparks, sunlight, other chemical degradation, or contamination.
