Directions for Use

Spray infested areas only until wet. Don't waste—a little goes a long way. TO SPRAY: Remove cap, point valve away from face, push button to release spray.

FOR FLYING INSECTS

Flies, Mosquitoes, Wasps, Gnats, Moths.

Outdoor Application:

Use only as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames or wherever these insects may enter premises. Also treat surfaces around light fixtures and any place where these insects congregate.

Indoor Application:

Close all doors and windows—spray mist upwards into the air, with a sweeping motion, keeping about 3 feet from interior walls, fabrics, furniture and plants. Spraying time of 3 to 4 seconds recommended for each 1,000 cubic feet of space. Do not remain in treated area. Keep room closed for 15 minutes then ventilate treated area. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects.

FOR CRAWLING INSECTS

Roaches, Waterbugs, Silverfish, Crickets.

Spray heavily into all cracks, around baseboards, and other places where these insects hide. Also spray until wet, surfaces behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, etc.

Ants: Spray trails, hills, around window sills and openings around pipes and baseboards, hitting as many insects as possible. Spray all localized areas infested with crawling pests. Repeat treatment as required to maintain effective control.

For Spiders, Centipedes, Sow bugs

Spray webs and places where they crawl. Hit as many as possible. Repeat as needed.

Bed Bugs, Moths, Carpet Beetles.

Spray exposed surfaces of infested articles thoroughly with a light mist. Spray entire bed thoroughly for bed bug control, especially seams and folds of mattresses. Treat back of carpets, crevices, joints on frames of furniture, closet shelving, floor, moldings and baseboards weekly to prevent breeding. The control of clothes moths depends on thorough coverage of all articles to be protected, paying particular attention to seams and folds. Applications should be repeated monthly unless the treated articles are stored in a moth-tight container. The interior surfaces of storage containers, such as closets and trunks should also be thoroughly sprayed in order that all moth larvae that may be feeding on lint in the cracks be killed.

Fleas: Spray floors, floor coverings and sleeping quarters for pet. Repeat spraying as often as necessary. Do not spray pets.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Keep out of reach of children. Avoid repeated or prolonged inhalation and skin contacts. Wash thoroughly after using. Do no use on household pets or humans.
Contents under pressure. Do not puncture container. Do not store at temperatures exceeding 120°F. Do not incinerate or spray into open flame. Cover fish bowls and remove birds for 1 hour when spraying rooms. Keep spray in constant motion at least 36 inches away from walls, fabrics, furniture, floors, plastics, etc. Avoid contamination of food. Cover exposed food.
