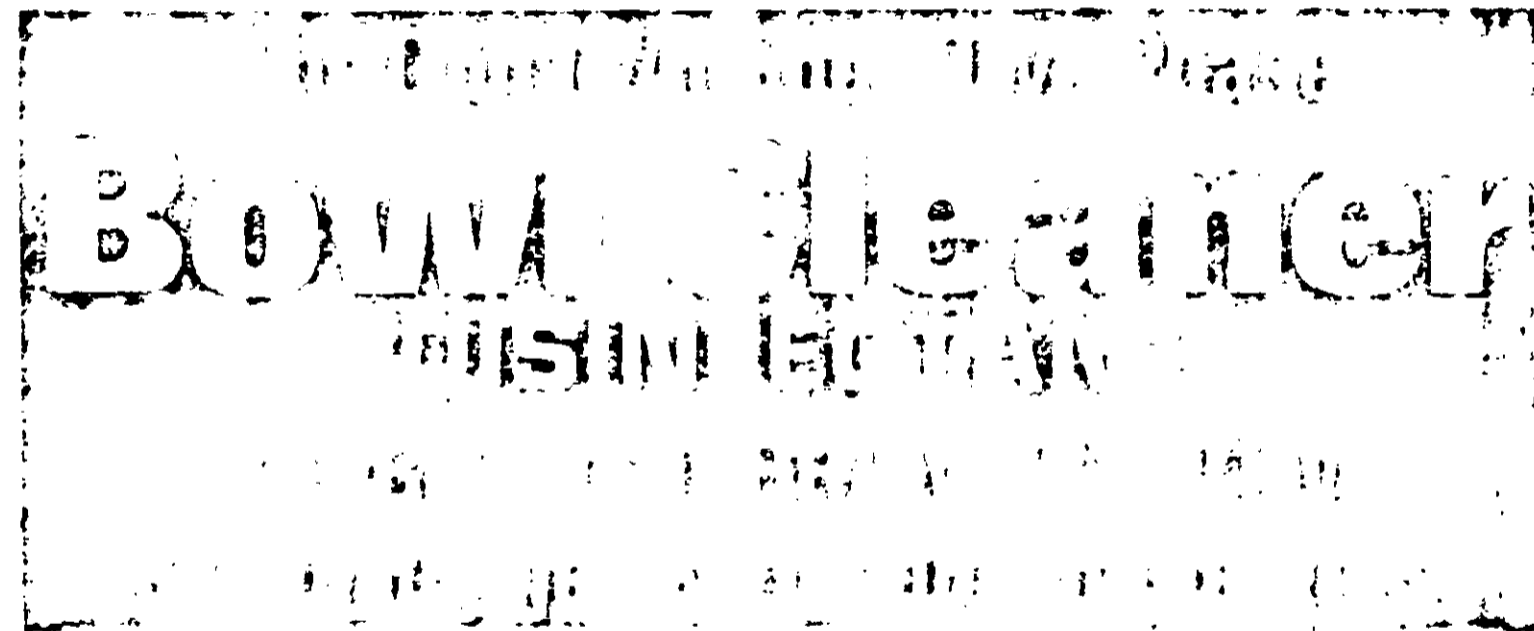
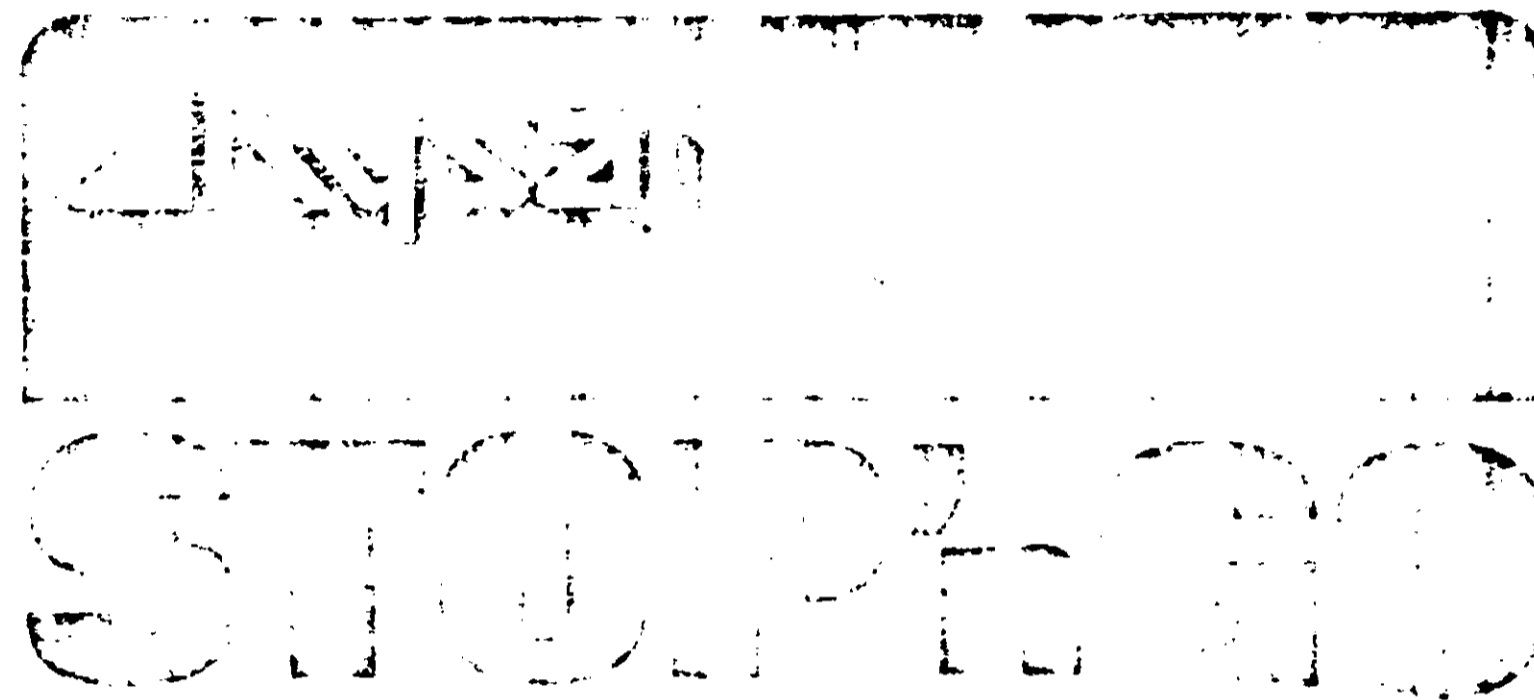
INTERNAL—Call a physician immediately.

Drink a teaspoonful or more of milk or magnesia or a cup of soapy water followed with milk or raw egg white.

EXTERNAL—Eyes. Wash with water for 15 minutes. Get prompt medical attention. Skin. Wash off acid gently, immediately flood the skin with water, using soap freely, then cover with moist magnesia or baking soda.

DIRECTIONS:

- Flush and remove as much waste as possible from the bowl by pulling up the trap with a bowl mop.
- Squirt by squeezing bottle into rim and on the entire inside surface.
- Dip the bowl mop into the solution in trap and scrub under rim and on the inside surfaces until solution changes color to green in color. Then flush.

TO CLEAN, DEODORIZE AND DISINFECT TOILET FLUSH BOXES:

- Shut off water supply and flush.
- Remove cover. Squirt completely into all surfaces.
- Scrub all surfaces with wet bowl mop until color turns green.
- Turn on water supply. Flush. Replace flush box cover.
