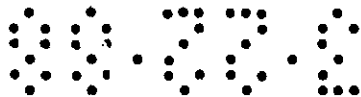

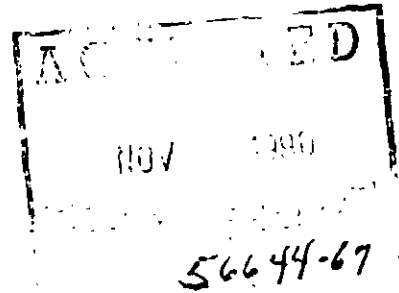

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

TO OPERATE: SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING. Turn nozzle to "spray" position before using. Hold pump sprayer 18 to 24 inches from foliage or surfaces being treated. Direct spray so that upper and lower leaf surfaces are contacted. Use caution on new growth and tender foliage.

This product may be used indoors, outdoors or in greenhouses throughout the growing season, or as preharvest treatment when other insecticides are prohibited due to residue restrictions and use limitations. This product may be applied on day of harvest.

To control the insects listed, direct the spray to cover the insect pest and also the upper and lower leaf surfaces. Begin treatment as soon as insects appear. Make sure spray penetrates dense foliage. Repeat application weekly or as needed to control infestations.

1. Change the Statement of Practical Treatment for eyes to read:

Flush with plenty of water while removing any contact lenses, then hold eyelids open and continue flushing with plenty of water.

2. Submit the product-specific product chemistry data for this product.
3. Add the phrase "Extremely Flammable" to the Physical and Chemical Hazards statement.
4. Provide the dielectrical breakdown voltage for the product or add the statement "Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard" to the use directions.
5. Submit a 1-year storage stability study. The formulated product must be analyzed for its active ingredients at time zero and during a year of storage. The storage must be under warehouse


