

# POOL ALGAECIDE 40

Active ingredient:

Pool Algaecide 40 is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools. For maximum effectiveness, pools containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using Pool Algaecide 40.

For pools having just visible algae growth, add an initial dose of 1 to 27 fl. oz. of Pool Algaecide 40 per 10,000 gal. of water and remove settled algae debris by clearing.

For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool, add initially 10 to 18 fl. oz. of Pool Algaecide 40 per 10,000 gal. of water.

To maintain pools free of visible algae growth, maintain conditions of 3.5 to 7 fl. oz. of Pool Algaecide 40 per 10,000 gal. of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after the initial treatment.

When distributing Pool Algaecide 40 throughout the water in the pool is necessary for maximum effectiveness.

Pool Algaecide 40 is compatible with most swimming pools normally used to treat pools and is effective against a wide variety of algae. Pool Algaecide 40 can be used in pools treated with chlorine or other sanitizers. The amount of these chemicals normally required, however, do not exceed 10 fl. oz. of Pool Algaecide 40 with a non-chlorine or liquid chlorine products.

## CAUTION:
