PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist. Provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and warm water after handling.

Remove pets and birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not use in commercial food processing or preparation areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food.

STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Remove contaminated clothing. Wash skin with soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
IF SWALLOWED: Get medical attention immediately.
NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine is an antidote.

PHYSICAL/CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Extremely flammable. Contents under pressure. Keep away from fire, sparks, and heated surfaces. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F (54°C) may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

GENERAL: Spray surface to wetting. Point spray away from people, pets, and plants. Do not use as a space spray. Use only for spot treatment.



Push straight DOWN for fine spray.



Push straight FORWARD for stream.

TO KILL ANTS, CRICKETS, EARWIGS, ROACHES, SILVERFISH, SOWBUGS, AND SPIDERS: Spray into cracks, crevices, around baseboards, and other places where these insects hide. Apply behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, and in and around waste containers. Contact directly as many insects as possible. For ants, spray trails and places where ants enter premises. Repeat as necessary for control.

TO KILL BROWN DOG TICKS AND FLEAS: Remove and destroy old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters after spray has dried. Do not spray animals. In addition, treat pets with a product registered for animal application to control the source of the flea infestation.

TO KILL CARPET BEETLES AND DERMESTIDS: Spray along baseboards, edges of carpeting, under carpets and rugs, under furniture, in closets, on shelving, and in other places of harborage. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

GENERAL: Do not contaminate other materials, including water, food, or feed during transport, use, storage, or disposal. If damaged or leaking, soak up and wrap waste, then dispose of as below.

STORAGE: Keep in a cool, dry, locked area inaccessible to children and away from flames, sparks, sunlight, or other sources of heat or ignition. Containers heated above 130°F (54°C) may burst.

DISPOSAL: Retasten protective cap on container, securely wrap in several layers of newspaper, and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
