PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION - Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin. In case of contact, immediately flush skin with plenty of water.

Do not use in commercial food processing or preparation areas. In homes, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use. Cover or remove exposed food.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Remove pets and birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying. This pesticide is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, ponds, or streams. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of waste.

PHYSICAL/CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F (54°C) may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

GENERAL - SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE. Hold container upright. Apply in short bursts.

INDOORS

To kill GNATS, HOUSEFLIES, MOSQUITOES, small flying MOTHS, and WASPS: Close all doors and windows, and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow, sweeping motion. Spray 5 to 10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects.

To kill ANTS, COCKROACHES, and CRICKETS: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray, in addition to a thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, in food storage areas, and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat doors, around window frames, ant trails, and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

To kill CARPET BEETLES: Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom of rugs and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture, and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

To kill exposed forms of CONFUSED FLOUR BEETLES, RICE WEEVILS, and SAW-TOOTHED GRAIN BEETLES: Find and destroy infested package goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. After shelves have dried, place clean paper on them and return packages. Repeat as necessary.

To kill CENTIPEDES, FIREBRATS, SOWBUGS, and SPIDERS: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also, thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, and hidden surfaces under sinks and behind stoves and refrigerators.

To kill BROWN DOG TICKS and FLEAS: Remove and destroy pet's old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray animals. Put fresh bedding in pet quarters after spray has dried. Also treat dogs and cats with a registered flea and tick control product before allowing them to enter treated area.

OUTDOORS

To kill GNATS, HOUSEFLIES, MOSQUITOES, and small flying MOTHS: Spray area infested with these flying insects. Hold container 18 to 24 inches (1/2 to 3/4 m) from shrubs, bushes, and grassy areas. Spray these areas with a slow, sweeping motion at the rate of 1 to 3 seconds per cubic yard (3/4 m³) of space, while moving away from the treated areas. To reduce annoyance from these pests, treat open porches and patios in a similar manner. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

GENERAL: Do not contaminate other materials, including water, food, or feed during transport, use, storage, or disposal. If damaged or leaking, soak up and wrap waste, then dispose of as below.

STORAGE: Keep in a cool, dry, locked area inaccessible to children and away from flames, sparks, sunlight, or other sources of heat or ignition. Containers heated above 130°F (54°C) may burst.

DISPOSAL: Retasten protective cap on container, securely wrap in several layers of newspaper, and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
