2. Place the following phrases listed below on the label of the product for shipment:

If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

If On Skin: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

- d. Change "Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes" to "Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters."
- e. Change "Do not treat horse stables if they will be used for food" to "Do not treat stables if horses will be used for food."
- f. Delete "Citrus Black Flies on nonbearing citrus" within the Directions for Use. See paragraph b., ~~above~~.
- g. The paragraph beginning, "Do not use in edible product areas of food processing plants . . . etc.," should appear as the second paragraph under the heading "Use Areas."
- h. The site hospitals should be qualified with the following phrase in parenthesis "(non-patient areas)."
- i. Following the instructions to treat carpets (after 4th sentence) add "Allow carpet to dry thoroughly before use."
- j. Add the following statement to the end of the instructions for bedbugs:

Allow treated articles to dry thoroughly before use.
- k. Use in food handling establishments can imply use in U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Meat and Poultry Plants. Therefore, either add the statement "Not for Use in USDA Meat and Poultry Plants," or submit an application to USDA requesting use in these areas. If granted, you can then indicate on the label that the product can be used in these areas.

3. Please provide the following product chemistry information:

- a. Provide the chemical identity, Material Safety Data Sheet, and CAS Number for the following:

#800801-K Dutch Spring S Perfume Oil, and

Cherry (blossom) Perfume #3*-761.

The supplier may contact us directly referencing your EPA Registration Number in their response.

For dyes, color index and CAS Numbers for all components are required. For perfumes and flavoring, all chemical components by CAS Numbers and percentage in the mixture must be identified. Certify that flavors are of nonfood type.

- c. Provide the flashpoint/flame extension. The flashpoint reported exceeds the one expected for this product. Please check and resubmit. Mixtures marketed under pressure, including those containing hydrocarbons, are subject in their entirety to tests indicated in Section 156.10(h)(2)(iii) of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations. (Flashpoints are conveniently measured after collecting the liquid expelled from the container in an open cup chilled with dry ice.)
- d. "Commercial aerosol container sizes" is not acceptable. Provide the actual sizes.

4. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
