


- c. The directions for sanitizing must provide instructions for removal of gross food particles and soil by a preflush, or prescrape and when necessary presoak treatment. Refer to the DIS/TSS-17 enclosure, item 4.
- d. The directions for sanitizing must include the contact time of at least 1 minute. Refer to the DIS/TSS-17 enclosure, item 3.
- e. Include a statement such as "Fresh sanitizing solution should be prepared at least daily or more often if the solution becomes diluted or soiled." Refer to the DIS/TSS-17 enclosure, item 4.
- f. Under "Beer & Soft Drink Plants" delete the statement "Just before resuming operation, flush the 25 ppm solution from equipment with potable water."
- g. Under "Sanitizing bottles and cans" change ". . . 8-12 ppm . . ." to read ". . . 8.5-12 ppm . . ."

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
