On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.
2. Change the label by revising the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 334-561".
3. Have your supplier submit, directly to us, the complete composition for the fragrance, P-0489 Herbal Pine Fragrance. All chemical components should be listed by CAS number and percent in the mixture.
4. Even though we would prefer inclusion, we have determined it is acceptable to remove the statement: "If you go to a doctor, take this repellent with you".

5. The primary dermal irritation study which you cited (MRID #418265-05) was found to be unacceptable. You must either submit or cite an acceptable study within one year of the date of this registration.

6. As a result of the review of the primary eye irritation study (MRID #422313-01) which you referenced, the following label changes must be made:

- a. The appropriate signal word is "WARNING".
- b. The precautionary statement should read as follow:

"Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid contact with eyes and lips. Do not allow children to rub their eyes if hands have been treated."

7. Delete the term "liberally" under the directions the Directions for Use. This is inconsistent with the Agency's intent as expressed in PR Notice 91-4.

8. Verify that the IF SWALLOWED text under the Precautionary Statements is appropriate for this product. A suggested precaution for this route of exposure would be as follows: "IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 of 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person."

9. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
