DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To spray, hold container upright and press firmly on sprayer. To repel the listed insects, apply just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Do not spray directly on face; spray first on hands, then rub on facial areas, avoiding eyes and lips. For ticks, chiggers, and fleas, also apply to shoe tops, socks, pants cuffs, and around openings in clothing. Repeat treatment as needed, but avoid overexposure. Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness.

After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing.

Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. If you suspect that you or your child is reacting to this product, wash treated skin and call your local Poison Control Center.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
