1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

a). Add the phrase, "EPA Registration No. 334-565" to the labeling before you release the product for shipment.

b). Remove the statement "Contains Petroleum Distillate" from the Precautionary Statements Section since it appears in the footnote of the ingredient statements, which is the appropriate place.

c). Revise the Statement of Practical Treatment as follow:

"IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention."

"IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention."

d). Revise the Precautionary Statements as follows:

"Harmful if inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash contaminated clothing before reuse."

e). The second paragraph in the precautionary statement section concerning use of product in commercial food processing serving areas should be placed under the "Directions for Use" Section in accordance with 40 CFR 156.1 (2) (X) (C).

f). Revise the section regarding non-food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments to read as follows:

**Not For Use In USDA Inspected Meat and Poultry Plants.**

"Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants, or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held." In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use.

Then add the following paragraphs:

"Food/Feed areas of commercial food/feed handling establishments where the product cannot be used include areas for receiving, serving, storage (dry, cold, frozen, raw), packaging (canning, slicing, cooking, grinding), edible waste storage, enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups).

Non-food areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

h). Since your data matrix does not provide a dielectrical breakdown voltage, you must add the following statement to the Physical or Chemical Hazards sub-heading:

"Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard."

2. The statement of Practical Treatment is normally required on the front panel, immediately below the child warning signal wording.

3. In reference to the confidential statement of formula (CSF), the following comments applies:

- a). Complete block #17 on the CSF.
- b). Complete block #13b for all actives (Nominal %). The ingredients should match the label in terms of % declared, and identity of each active ingredients.

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

### FEATURES, CLAIMS AND USES

A broad-spectrum residual crawling insect spray with synergized synthetic pyrethroid for quick knockdown and Evercide® for long-lasting residual control of ants, roaches and other listed insects.

**Residually Kills:** Ants, Cockroaches, Ticks, Fleas, Black Widow Spiders, Carpet Beetles, Cockroaches, Crickets, Scorpions, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders.

Outdoor, use to kill flies and mosquitoes as they come to rest on treated surfaces.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:** Harmful if swallowed, absorbed through skin, or inhaled. Contains petroleum distillate. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration pneumonia hazard. **SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE**  
General Use: Use this spray as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control cockroaches, fleas, silverfish, ticks, waterbugs, and other insects listed below. Apply

this product only as a crack and crevice treatment to localized areas found or may occur. Spray Repeat as needed.

**FOR SPOT TREATMENT:** T Widow Spiders, Carpet Beetles, Crickets, Scorpions, Silverfish, Spiders; Spray areas where found or may hide, including rooms and closets; cracks and along baseboards and door and behind and beneath sinks, stoves and cabinets; and around garbage cans, and other utility installations of hiding places, should be sprayed, spray ant trails and around doors, and wherever else these insects may be found. Repeat as necessary. **To Kill Ticks and Fleas:** Thorough spot treatment to infested areas and resting quarters, nearby areas along and behind baseboards, frames, and localized areas of floors where these pests may hide. Old bedding should be removed with clean, fresh bedding and NOT SPRAY PETS WITH THIS product. This should be treated with a registered control product prior to reentering. **FOR CRACK AND CREVICE:** Kill Ants, Black Widow Spiders, Beetles, Cockroaches, Crickets, Scorpions, Silverfish, Sowbugs. Apply spray in small amounts in cracks and crevices. Equipment capable of stream should be used in larger elements of construction and floors, openings less than 1/2 inch in diameter, such as hollow spaces in walls, equibases where these insects hide. Care should be taken to avoid product onto exposed surfaces material into the air. Avoid contact with food handling surfaces.

**Flies and Mosquitoes:** Use or aid in reducing annoyance by spraying outside surfaces of frames as well as other areas pests may enter the home. Ants and localized nesting areas (eaves) or porches, patios, and these insects may congregate. Treat with this product to kill ants coming to rest on treated areas. Repeat treatment when necessary.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Do not contaminate (including water/food/food) during storage, and disposal. If do not use, seal and wrap any waste, below.

**STORAGE:** Keep in a cool, inaccessible to children and of heat and radiation (including surfaces, and sunlight). Do not store above 130° F (54° C) may burst.

**DISPOSAL:** Release product or, securely wrap in several layers and discard in trash. Do not reuse.
