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Shock Treatment

Shock Treatment is a special treatment to shock your pool and to reach the maximum level of chlorine. When a pool is being shocked, the chlorine level should be raised to 10 PPM. At a certain point, the chlorine compounds combining with the bacteria are exhausted. If these compounds are exhausted, the chlorine level will drop. Super-chlorinate your pool by adding enough chlorine to raise the level to 10 PPM (This should be done in the evening). The next morning the chlorine level should be checked to be sure that at least 1 PPM is left in the pool. If this does not happen, the procedure should be repeated. (Check on the chlorine level in the pool if the chlorine level is above 1 PPM.)

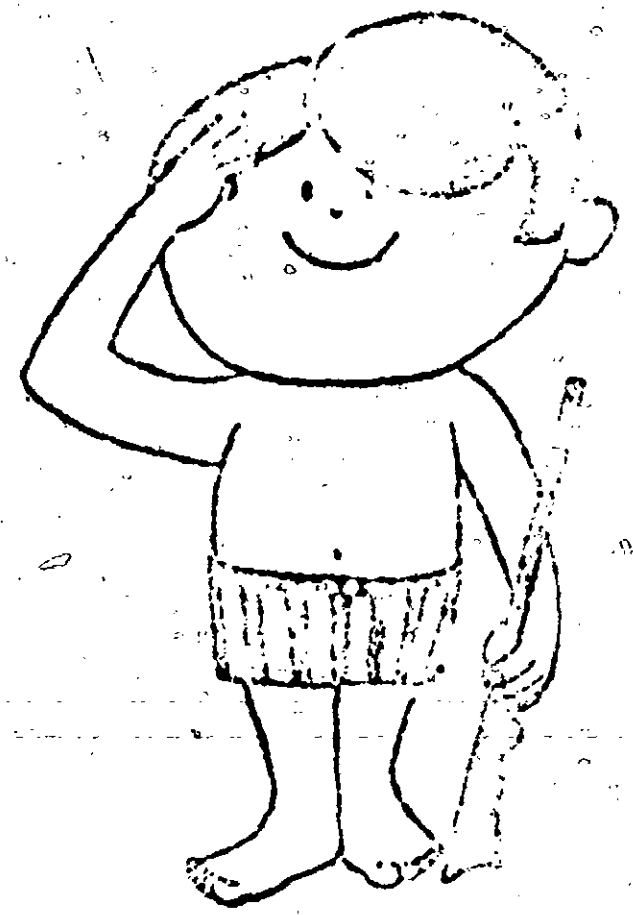

1. Vinyl pools dismantled for the off season.

- a. Clean or backwash filter.
- b. Empty pool, drain all pipes,
lines, pumps and filters.
- c. Scrub liner with proper cleanser
(consult your dealer).
- d. Rinse well with clean water.
- e. Let the liner dry thoroughly.
- f. Store as directed by manufacturer.
- g. Store all chemicals in the original
