



# PENNWALT M-S-A<sup>TM</sup>

## MILDEWSTATIC FABRIC CONDITIONER

Prevents the growth of mildew for a period of at least four weeks when fabrics are treated according to directions for use.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

1. Use at the rate of 2 fluid ounces per 100 lbs. of fabric (dry weight).
2. Adjust water level for sour operation. Prior to souring, add PENNWALT M-S-A directly to the washwheel and run for 2 minutes.
3. Add normal sour requirements to same bath and run for an additional 6 minutes.
4. Drain washwheel, extract and finish in the usual manner.
5. In order to insure continued control of mildew growth, re-treat fabrics as necessary.

**NOTE:** Avoid use of metal containers, metal dippers or metal pumps in conjunction with PENNWALT M-S-A. Polyethylene or other plastic containers, dippers, etc. are recommended.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.
