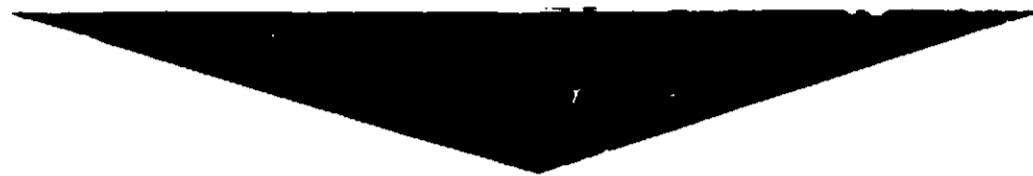
Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate use of alcohol. Measure against circulatory shock. See also section on first aid.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

PennsWim is a chemical compound that destroys all types of algae and other aquatic organisms. For the best treatment, use after the water has been filtered. Use one gallon of PENNSWIM ALGAECIDE NO. 2 for each 50,000 gallons of water (1 quart in 12,500 gallons) once per week with one quart of PENNSWIM ALGAECIDE NO. 2 for 10,000 gallons of water if algae growth is visible, and one quart for each one gallon of PENNSWIM ALGAECIDE NO. 2 for every 10,000 gallons of water. Stop the algae growth soon after several treatments.

Maximum dosage should be applied at least 2-3 days into the treatment of the pool with appearance temperature ranging from 60-80°F (15-27°C).

For swimming pools, use one gallon of PENNSWIM ALGAECIDE NO. 2 for 50,000 gallons of water. This dosage, along with regular filtration, will control algae growth during the water season.

Use one quart of PENNSWIM ALGAECIDE NO. 2 for every 10,000 gallons of water in swimming pools.
