DIRECTIONS FOR USE

SUPER ALGAE BLAST CONCENTRATE 90 is especially designed for super-chlorination and algae control in ~~in~~ **ground pools**. It is not recommended for vinyl-lined pools. Before application treatment remove visible algae growth by brushing the affected surfaces. Using a pH Test Kit and proper additives, adjust the pH of pool water to 7.4-7.8 and then add SUPER ALGAE BLAST CONCENTRATE 90 on top or near to the visible algae growth. Use about 3/4-1 oz. per 1,000 gallons of water to establish the initial chlorine residual of at least 4 ppm as determined by a suitable chlorine test kit. If algae growth persists, the treatment should be repeated. Do not allow swimming in the pool during this local super-chlorination treatment until the residual chlorine in the pool drops to below 2 ppm level as determined by chlorine test kit.

DANGER: Keep out of reach of children. Causes eye damage. Corrosive to skin tissues. Causes irritation of skin, nose and throat. May be fatal or harmful if swallowed.
