PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals:

DANGER KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. CORROSIVE. CAUSES EYE AND SKIN DAMAGE. HARMFUL OR FATAL IF SWALLOWED.

First Aid: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If swallowed: Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or, if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

Spills: **Small Spills:** Neutralize the active iodine with a reducing agent such as sodium sulfite (trisulfate) and flush with cold water down the drain. **Large Spills:** Absorb spill on sawdust, clay or other suitable inert absorbent material. Dispose in sanitary landfill or in aeration or make water. Neutralize with sodium sulfite (trisulfate) at 1 lb. per 5 lbs. of the spilled product. Adjust the pH and flush to sewer. Follow applicable local, state, and Federal codes.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge to lakes, streams, ponds, or other public waterways without an appropriate NPDES permit. For NPDES permits, contact your regional EPA office or the appropriate agency in your state.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed: Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or, if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

If in eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician immediately.

If on skin: Flush skin with plenty of water.

Note to Physician: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

For formulating use only. To be used in formulating sanitizers and disinfectants (germicides). Not for use as is or in simple aqueous dilutions.

REGISTRATION OF PRODUCTS

Sanitizer and disinfectant products must be registered with the Environmental Protection Agency, Washington, D.C. 20250.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Iodofoam Concentrate 20 may be stored in glass, fiberglass or plastic containers. Because of corrosion, metal containers should be avoided.

Prohibitions: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide, spray mixture, or rinse that cannot be used or chemically processed should be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

General: Consult federal, state or local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures.
