

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Manufacturing Use:
 Use in Reformulation of Other Registered Pesticides. This product may be used as a source of the active ingredient in the formulation of sanitizers, disinfectants and antimicrobial/biocidal products registered under FIFRA. These applications include: Air washer and evaporative condenser systems; Commercial industrial recirculating and once through cooling water systems; Pulp and Paper Mill systems; Pasteurizer cooling water systems.
 This product may be used in the manufacture of Peroxy Acid formulations used as sanitizers, disinfectants and antimicrobial/biocidal products registered under FIFRA. These applications include: Batch sanitization; Biologing control; Formulating into end use disinfectants; Surface disinfection; Sterilization/disinfection of hospital non-critical items. Circulation cleaning and institutional /industrial sanitizing; Egg processing/packing equipment surfaces; Eating establishments.

Formulators using this product for applications/uses not listed are also responsible for FIFRA registration of their products and for compliance with other FIFRA requirements.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
