

FOR TREATING FLAKE POSTS, LUMBER, POLES AND STRUCTURAL LUMBER AGAINST ROT, DECAY
AND MOLD - AN EFFECTIVE SOIL POISON: CONTROLS TERMITES, AND MOSS ON ROOFS.

DIRECTIONS

TREATING STRUCTURAL LUMBER: Best results will be had by soaking wood for at least 24 hours. Cover with 1 1/2 inches of water or immerse with at least two flowing coats. Solution will treat 100 to 250 sq. feet of surface per gallon.

TREATING POLES, POSTS, HEAVY TIMBERS: Use dry, seasoned wood from which all bark has been removed. Depth of treatment on pole or post can be increased by incising. A 50-gal. open head steel drum can be used for treating short posts. Fill drum with posts, then add Pentagard until drum is filled. Let soak at least 24 hours and, if necessary, reverse the posts and soak other ends for additional 24 hours. Set posts any time after treatment. Figure 1 gallon per each 2 cubic feet of wood for 24-hour soaking. This method cannot be used, brushing or spraying the solution will provide protection in proportion to the quantity of solution absorbed by the wood.

TO CONTROL MOSS ON WOOD SHINGLE ROOFS: One application is sufficient, after which, when moss is dead, sweep it from the roof and make another application to prevent regrowth. Avoid spray drift or drip from roof onto valuable plants as they will be killed or seriously injured.

AS A SOIL POISON FOR TERMITES: Dig a trench 30 inches deep and the top of footings or pilings is the lower. Trench must extend 10 feet beyond termite mound. Use 1 gallon of material per 100 sq. ft. of soil including back fill.
