## GENERAL INFORMATION

Du Pont "Kloben" Neburon Weed Killer is recommended for use in commercial nurseries, plantings of certain woody ornamental plants for the control of annual weeds and grasses. It is a wettable powder to be mixed in water for spray application to the surface of the ground. Effects will not become apparent until the chemical has been carried into the root zone of the germinating weeds by moisture. It is non-corrosive, non-flammable, non-volatile, and is low in toxicity to man and animals under recommended conditions of use. Unless otherwise directed, do not treat any area which may be replanted to any crop within one year of treatment as crop injury may result.

"Kloben" should be used only in accordance with recommendations on this label and separate Du Pont Agricultural Bulletins available through local dealers.

## DIRECTIONS

For use in Field Plantings of Arborvitae, Chamaecyparis, Euonymus, Firethorn, Forsythia, Honeysuckle, Juniper, Pine, Privet, Yew

"Kloben" selectively controls seedling and till weeds such as chickweed, corn spurry, pigweed, smartweed, xanthoxylum, proso millet, and annual grasses such as crabgrass and annual bluegrass. Field tiller weeds should be removed by cutting or pulling prior to application of the herbicide. Surface soil should be kept moist and soil temperatures should be maintained at the level recommended on this label.

**Equipment** - Equipment used for application of "Kloben" should be thoroughly cleaned after use to prevent contamination of other crops. Do not use equipment which has been used for application of other herbicides. Keep equipment clean and free of weeds and grasses. Apply "Kloben" uniformly as a directed spray to the surface of cultivated soil. Do not spray foliage of nursery stock as injury to some species may result. Apply at the rate of 8 lbs. per acre of area actually sprayed as a blanket or band treatment. Avoid overlapping and shut off spray booms while starting, turning, slowing or stopping. Avoid contact with plants. For small areas, apply uniformly at the rate of 4 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. or more gals. of water.

**When to Apply** - Apply just prior to germination and growth of annual weeds. Best results are obtained if the herbicide is moved by moisture into the upper layer of soil within two weeks after application. Do not apply more than once per year as crop injury may result.

**Note** - Do not apply around newly transplanted ornamentals until they are well established. Water to settle the soil around the base of the plant.
