





DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Du Pont Hyvar- X Weed Killer is recommended for use in Florida citrus groves where trees have been established less than one year (nonbearing). (For use in groves established more than one year, see product label.) Treatment controls annual weed, including barnyardgrass (watergrass), crabgrass, crowfootgrass, Florida pusley, henbit, lambsquarters, mustard, natalgrass (red top), puncturevine, purslane, sandbur, sedge (annual), sprangletop, and Texas panicum (Coloradograss); and perennial weeds including bermudagrass, bahiagrass, pangolagrass, paragrass and torpedograss. For perennials, repeated applications are required; partial control usually occurs with a single treatment.

How to Use - Trees Established Less Than One Year

Apply 2 to 3 lbs. per acre as needed to maintain weed control. Do not apply at less than 60-day intervals; do not apply more than 6 lbs. per acre within any 6-month period or more than 8 lbs. per acre during the first year.

Note: Temporary yellowing of citrus leaves may occur following treatment. Rainfall or overhead irrigation is necessary to activate the herbicide. Repeat applications should not be made unless prior applications have been activated. Because injury to citrus trees may result: do not use on soils less than 1/2% in organic matter, poorly drained soils, gravelly soils, or thinly covered or exposed subsoils; do not treat trees planted in irrigation furrows; do not treat diseased trees such as those with foot rot.

Do not replant treated areas to any crop except citrus within two years after last application as injury to subsequent crops may result.
