It is effective against a wide range of turf weeds, such as: goose grass, hairy wood-grass, crab grass, and many other weeds. It is also effective against annual weeds, such as: chickweed, dandelion, and many others. It is highly effective for the control of crab grass (smooth and hairy), and may be used on newly seeded areas as well as on established turf. Because of its high degree of selectivity, Tupersan[®] may be applied at time of seeding without causing injury to germinating seeds. It may be used in temperate regions.

New Fall Plantings and Established Turf

Except for small areas, use a fixed boom power sprayer properly calibrated to a constant speed and rate of delivery. Make certain spray equipment is clean (free of scale, rust, dirt, oil, and pasticide deposits). Openings in screens should be 50 microns or larger. Material must be kept moving past the filter by constant water flow. Watch for clogging of the hydrocyclone in the spray zone. If it plugs or returns, stop using it. If it returns, shut it down and clean to remove the plug. **Do Not Use Air Agitation** in the spray zone. Do not be startled when starting a turbine slow to start, stop, or surge. If the turbine is not the same size as the tank, it will surge more frequently and should be frequently **Noted**. Use only one agitator per tank. If a crop is used for a long period of time,
