DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SINBAR® is recommended for use in newly planted and young non-bearing apple, pear, peach, plum, apricot and cherry trees.

For control of annual weeds in newly-planted fruit trees, apply SINBAR® at 0.5 to 1 lb/A by ground application. Make the first application after a significant rainfall or irrigation event that will allow the ground to settle around the base of the tree prior to application. Make 1 to 2 applications per season.

After the planting year, SINBAR® may be applied to young non-bearing fruit trees at the rate of 0.5 to 1 lb/A by ground application. Make 1 to 2 applications per season.

Do not use on soils coarser than sandy loams with less than 2% organic matter.

Do not use more than 1 lb/A per year.

Do not use in the state of California.
