

## GENERAL INFORMATION

Du Pont "Zobair" I Weed Killer is a wettable powder to be mixed in water and applied as a spray for selective control of weeds in apple and peach orchards. It is non corrosive to equipment, non volatile and non flammable.

"Zobair" I controls certain perennial grasses and annual weeds such as ~~chickweed, clover, dandelion, henbit, lamb's ears, morning glory, nutcracker, peppergrass, purple, plantain, purple, smartweed, yellowrocket, barnyard grass (water grass), john grass, crab grass, fall panicum, foxtail, orchardgrass, quackgrass, and ryegrass~~

Moisture is necessary to activate the herbicide. Best results are obtained if moisture is supplied by rainfall or irrigation within two weeks after application. The degree of control and duration of effect will vary with the amount applied, soil texture, rainfall, and other conditions.

## DIRECTIONS

Du Pont "Zobair" I Weed Killer should be used only in accordance with recommendations on this label, or in separate published Du Pont recommendations available through local dealers.

**APPLES, PEACHES**—Use only where trees have been established in the orchard for at least 2 years. Make a single band or broadcast application to the ground beneath and/or between trees at the following rates in the spring or fall (postharvest) before weeds emerge or during the early stage of growth. Avoid contact of fruit with spray or mist; do not spray foliage as injury to trees may result.

Broadcast Treatment (for band treatment, use proportionately less)

\* Do not use on sand, silty sand, or clayey silts in orchards containing less than 1% organic matter, or on other trees where substantial tree damage or injury to trees may result.

Where crop is grown under furrow irrigation or under raised-berm flood irrigation (trees 4 to 6" above waterline), apply only as band treatment. Do not treat trees planted in the bottom of irrigation furrows, nor trees grown under flat flood or basin irrigation as injury to trees may result.

Apply with a fixed boom power spray properly calibrated to a constant speed and rate of delivery. Continuous agitation in the spray tank is required to keep the material in suspension. Avoid overlapping and shut off spray booms while starting, turning, slowing or stopping or injury to the crop may result.

Where complete weed control to harvest is desired, additional weed control measures may be required during the growing season. Do not replant treated areas to any other crop within 2 years after application as injury to subsequent crops may result.
