Frentox Liquid Household Insecticide
EPA Registration No. 657-100
Your Applications Dated June 30 and December 12, 1983

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable and a stamped copy is enclosed for your records. The following corrections should be brought to the attention of your printer when setting up the actual printed finished labels.

1. Add a comma between Piperonyl butoxide and Technical.
2. Add an opening bracket immediately before the diazinon formula name O,O-diethyl etc. (note the replacement of the period between the O,O with a comma).
3. In the footnote revise the spelling of the first chemical name to read Butylcarbityl and use a lower case E for ether.
4. It is noted that you have listed the environmental Hazards section and Physical Hazards section. These should appear as in our letter of June 8, 1983, with the exception that the statement "Exposure to temperatures above 110°F may cause bursting" should be deleted as this only applies to pressurized products.
5. In the first two ticks directions in the last sentence to read "Do not spray animals with this product."
