Du Pont "Lannate" Insecticide is recommended for use on apples to control apple aphid in areas east of the Rocky Mountains.

HOW TO USE

Apply 1/8 to 1/2 lb. per 100 gals. to established infestations and repeat as needed.

Apply in sufficient water to obtain thorough coverage (run-off) but not in excess of 400 gals. per acre.

Note: Do not apply to Early MacIntosh or Wealthy apple varieties. Do not apply within 8 days of harvest. Do not graze livestock in treated orchards for 10 days after treatment.
