Du Pont "Lannate" Insecticide is recommended in combination with the bacterium, Bacillus thuringiensis<sup>1/</sup> for control of loopers, imported cabbageworm and diamondback moth on broccoli, Brussels sprouts, cabbage and cauliflower.

## HOW TO USE

### LOOPERS

Apply 1/2 lb. "Lannate" plus 1/2 lb. Bacillus thuringiensis<sup>1/</sup> per acre.

### IMPORTED CABBAGEWORM, DIAMONDBACK MOTH

Apply 1/4 to 1/2 lb. "Lannate" plus 1/2 to 1/4 lb. Bacillus thuringiensis<sup>1/</sup> per acre. Apply the higher use rates on severe insect infestations.

Apply when larval populations appear in significant numbers and continue at 5- to 7-day intervals or as needed. Apply in sufficient water (minimum 3 gals. per acre by air) to obtain thorough coverage.

Note: Do not apply within the following days of harvest:

Cabbage	-	1 day
Broccoli, Brussels sprouts and cauliflower	-	3 days
