Du Pont "Lannate" Methomyl Insecticide is recommended for use on oranges, lemons, grapefruit, tangelos and tangerines for control of spirea aphid in Florida.

HOW TO USE

Apply "Lannate" at 1/2 to 1 lb. per acre. Use sufficient water to obtain thorough coverage (use a minimum of 15 gals./acre by air). Use the higher rate on severe infestations of aphids. Make additional applications as needed.

Note: Do not apply within 1 day of harvest. Do not graze livestock in treated orchards for 10 days after treatment. This product is toxic to bees and should not be applied when bees are actively visiting the area.
