LANNATE® INSECTICIDE
FOR USE ON PEACHES

Du Pont "Lannate" Insecticide is recommended for use on peaches for control of catfacing insects (plant bugs and stink bugs).

HOW TO USE

Apply 1 to 2 lbs. "Lannate" per acre by ground concentrate sprayer using sufficient water volume for thorough coverage. For dilute sprays, use 1/4 to 1/2 lb. per 100 gals. and spray to run-off (400 gals./acre maximum). Begin applications at petal fall. Continue treatment in cover sprays at 7- to 10-day intervals.

Note: "Lannate" is toxic to bees and should not be applied when bees are actively visiting the area. Do not treat within 4 days of harvest. Do not graze livestock in treated orchards for 10 days after treatment.
