FOR USE ON GRAPES

Du Pont "Lannate" Insecticide is recommended for use on grapes to control omnivorous leafroller, grape leaf folder, and orange tortrix.

### HOW TO USE

Apply 1/2 to 1 lb. "Lannate" per acre by ground equipment in sufficient water to obtain thorough coverage. Good coverage is particularly important in the case of insects which directly attack the grape berries.

Grape Leaf folder and Omnivorous Leafroller - Make the first application when insects appear in damaging numbers or when leaf folding is observed. Repeat at 5- to 7-day intervals or as needed.

Orange Tortrix - Make the first application when insects appear in damaging numbers in spring growth. Repeat at 5- to 7-day intervals or as needed.

Note: Do not treat within one day of harvest; do not treat grapes for wine within 14 days of harvest.
