Du Pont Lannate® Insecticide is recommended for use on oranges, lemons, grapefruit, tangelos, and tangerines for control of yellow scale, chaff scale, purple scale, glover scale, and soft brown scale in Arizona, California, and Florida.

HOW TO USE

Apply 1/2 lb. Lannate® per 100 gals. water as a dilute spray (800 gals. per acre maximum). Thorough coverage is essential for control.

Note: Do not apply within 7 days of harvest. Do not graze livestock in treated orchards for 10 days after treatment. This product is toxic to bees and should not be applied when bees are actively visiting the area.
