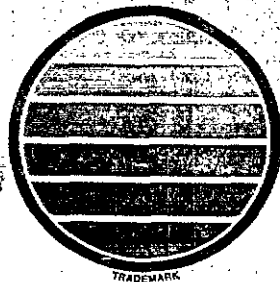

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DuPont "BENLATE" Fungicide is recommended for the control of white mold (Sclerotinia) on radish grown for seed.

HOW TO USE

Apply 32 oz of "BENLATE" per acre. Apply at first petal fall. Repeat at 14 day intervals. Add a spreader sticker to aid in wetting plants. For aerial application use a minimum of 5 gallons per acre.

Do not graze livestock in treated areas.

Do not use treated seed or plant parts for food or feed.

Do not apply more than 96 oz (6 lbs) of "BENLATE" per acre per crop.
