Apple Aphid, Rosy Apple Aphid - Apply 1 to 2 pts. per 100 gals. to established infestations and repeat as needed.

<u>Codling Moth</u> - Make applications of 1 to 2 pts. per 100 gals. at 10- to 12-day intervals beginning when infestations first appear.

<u>Tufted Apple Budmoth</u> - Apply 1 to 2 pts. per 100 gals. when insects first appear and repeat treatment as needed to maintain control.

Fruittree Leafroller, Obliquebanded Leafroller, Redbanded Leafroller, Variegated Leafroller, Lesser Appleworm, White Apple Leafhopper, Tentiform Leafminer - Apply 2 pts. per 100 gals. when insects first appear and repeat treatments as needed to maintain control.

Apply in sufficient water to obtain thorough coverage (run-off) but not in excess of 400 gals. per acre. For concentrate sprayers, use proportionately less water.

Note: Do not apply to Early MacIntosh or Wealthy apple varieties. Do not apply within 8 days of harvest. Do not graze livestock in treated orchards for 10 days after treatment.
