Du Pont Vydate® L Insecticide/Nematicide is recommended for use on peanuts to control root knot (except Javonese), sting, ring and lesion nematodes, and thrips. Vydate® L may be used as a soil treatment at planting or as a foliar treatment to supplement soil applications of Vydate® L or other contact nematicides or soil fumigants.

HOW TO USE

Soil Treatment - Apply 2 to 6 qts. of Vydate® L in a 7" to 12" band using a minimum of 10 gallons of water per acre. Thoroughly incorporate with a rotary tiller to a depth of 3" to 5" immediately after application. Use the higher rate and wider band for severe insect and nematode infestations. Peanuts should be planted within 24 hours after application. Alternatively, Vydate® L may be applied in a 7" band immediately behind planting. Use 2 to 6 qts. in a minimum of 10 gallons water per acre.

Foliar Treatment - Foliar treatment is to be used only following soil fumigation, or following preplant or at planting soil application of Vydate® L or other contact nematicides. Make 2 foliar applications of Vydate® L at 2 to 4 pts. per acre in 20 to 40 gallons of water. Apply first spray 3 weeks after emergence and the second spray 6 weeks after emergence. For best results, concentrate the spray on the row using 3 cone-type nozzles positioned over and to each side of the row. Thorough spray coverage is important.

Note: Apply only as directed. Make no additional applications of Vydate® L.
