1. Provided that you revise the proposed labeling "Statement of Practical Treatment": "IF SWALLOWED" statements to read: "Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Do not induce vomiting. Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol."; and add a "NOTE TO PHYSICIAN", that contains such information as:
 - o Technical information on symptomatology.
 - o Use of supportive treatments to maintain life function.
 - o Medicine that will counteract the specific physiological effects of the pesticide;
 and add the statement "Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage."

2. Submit one (1) copy of the proposed final printed label submitted with your application dated September 11, 1997 before you release the product for shipment under that label.
