DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is in violation of federal law to use these products in a manner inconsistent with their labeling.

DuPont "Ally" Herbicide may be applied in tank mix with formulations of "Banvel" and 2,4-D that are registered for use on Durum wheat in accordance with their labels. Observe all applicable directions, restrictions and precautions on labels of all products used.

This 3-way combination provides postemergence activity and offers potential for short-term residual control or suppression of labeled weeds. Degree of control and duration of effect depend on weed spectrum and density, weed size and variability, amount of canopy cover, growing conditions prior to, at and following application, amount and timing of precipitation and spray coverage.

USE RATE

"Ally" 1/10 oz + 2 - 3 oz "Banvel" (4 - 6 oz "Banvel" SGF) + 4 - 6 oz active 2,4-D Ester or Amine (based on 4 lb ai/gallon formulation) per acre. Use higher rates when weed infestation is heavy.

CROP STAGE AT APPLICATION:

Apply this 3-way combination after the crop is tillering and before the Durum exceeds the 5-leaf stage.

PRECAUTIONS

Do not apply this 3-way mixture more than once in a 22-month period.

Do not use on soils with a pH greater than 7.9.

Read and follow "Ally" product label directions for crop rotation guidelines.
