### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product  
in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Du Pont Classic® Herbicide is recommended for aerial application to soybeans.

### SPRAY TANK PREPARATION

"Classic" should be thoroughly mixed with water in the spray tank before adding any other material (e.g., surfactant). Agitation is required for uniform mixing and application. Apply "Classic" spray preparation within 24 hours of product mixing or product degradation may occur. Thoroughly re-agitate before using if allowed to settle.

### APPLICATION RECOMMENDATION

Use 1/2 to 3/4 oz. "Classic" per acre. Applications should be made by air or ground equipment only to young actively growing weeds. Applications of "Classic" must include a surfactant of 0.25% (v/v). Use a good quality surfactant of at least 80% active ingredient to improve wetting and/or contact activity of "Classic".

Under hot dry conditions 1% v/v (1 gal/100 gal) crop oil concentrate may improve control over surfactant. Use a petroleum based crop oil concentrate of good quality with at least 15% emulsifiers/surfactant. Crop oil concentrate will increase phytotoxicity to soybeans, however.

**BEST AVAILABLE COPY**

Use a minimum of 3 gallons water per acre. Do not apply during air inversion conditions, when winds are gusty, or when other conditions will favor poor coverage and/or drift. Use appropriate spray nozzle types, cores, and orifice disks in proper arrangement to deliver optimum spray distribution and maximum coverage.

Under heavy weed pressure or dense crop foliage, increase minimum spray volume to 5 gallons per acre by air and use higher spray pressures.

Do not apply "Classic" if rain is expected within 4 hours, or weed control may be decreased.

A second application of "Classic" at 1/2 oz per acre may be made two to three weeks after the initial application if conditions warrant. Do not exceed 1 oz total "Classic" per session.

**IMPORTANT**

Before using "Classic", read and carefully observe the cautionary statements, use precautions, all label instructions and "Classic" Recrop Table.

This bulletin contains new or supplemental instructions for use of this product which may not appear on the package label. Follow the instructions carefully.

This labeling must be in the possession of the user at the time of pesticide application.
